FIRST AWARDS OF 2017 FOR KECHRIS WINERY

The first awards of the year for KECHRIS winery came from the Vinalies Internationales competition that steadily opens the series of awards for our wines over the last years. Continuing an impressive track record of success, which now includes 4 consecutive gold medals in the last 4 competitions, TEAR OF THE PINE 2016, our 100% Assyrtiko retsina, earned another golden distinction, one out of a total of 6 awarded to Greek wines. In the same competition, KECHRIBARI 2016, our 100% Roditis retsina, also won an important award, this time a silver medal, after one gold and two more silver in the previous 4 years.

A few days later KECHRIS wines received new prestigious distinctions at the Thessaloniki International Wine and Spirits Competition. TEAR OF THE PINE 2016 received its second gold medal for 2017, showing that this year has started with the best of omens, while the second award for our wines came for XINOMAVRO 2013, a unique expression of the Goumenissa terroir, which received a silver medal.

The continuous successes of KECHRIS wines in all major international competitions have placed retsina and indigenous Greek varieties among the best examples of the international vineyard. Along with the growing preference for these wines in Greece and abroad, these awards are a confirmation of their consistent high quality and give us greater motive to continue on the same creative path that we follow for more than a century.
